

# Notice of Motion: Proposal for Change to Dress Code

This Notice of Motion is submitted to propose a change to the current dress code policy. The intent is to ensure that our dress code reflects the evolving needs and expectations of our organisation, promotes inclusivity, and allows for greater comfort and flexibility for all playing members.

**Proposal to allow the new club shirt to replace the current National Shirt. This would allow Members the need to only purchase one shirt for both Club Leagues /Competitions and National competitions.**

### Present:

**Dress Rule for Ladies**> The dress rule for Ladies playing in Leagues/ Club competitions shall be: Above the waist predominantly white or cream top, as supplied by a bowls wear supplier, with turned down collar with either long or short sleeves, or maroon or white club polo shirt, white, cream or maroon cardigan, waistcoat or sweater, grey regulation bowling skirt, or plain grey or black regulation bowling trousers, shorts if worn to be grey of black as supplied by a bowls wear supplier, regulation bowling shoes.

Do not travel in your bowling shoes, anyone doing so will be liable for any damage caused in the bowls hall.

**The Following are not permitted. The Club National Shirt, Tee Shirts, Jean Type Trousers, Track Suit Bottoms or Striped Trousers.**

**Dress Rule for Men**> The dress rule for men playing in Leagues/ Club competitions shall be: Above the waist predominantly white or cream top, as supplied by a bowls wear supplier, with turned down collar with either long or short sleeves, or maroon or white club polo shirt, white, cream or maroon cardigan, or sweater, grey or black regulation bowling trousers, shorts if worn to be grey of black as supplied by a bowls wear supplier, regulation bowling shoes.

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
